

Athlete Substance Abuse Contract

Substance abuse is dangerous to the health and proper functioning of individuals. Athletic competition requires a student to be in the best possible health and physical condition. Athletics and substance abuse are not compatible, and individual students must choose to avoid all forms to participate in interscholastic athletics.

Athlete: I recognize that there are many potentially destructive decisions I face everyday. I will do everything in my power to avoid making decisions that will jeopardize my health and safety.

By signing below, I pledge my best effort to remain school and drug free and agree to abide by the following guidelines found in the district substance abuse policy.

1. If suspected or observed under the influence of an illegal substance, I will not be permitted to play in an interscholastic game until an information seminar is held with the coach, parents, school nurse, social worker and athletic director.
2. If a second suspected or observed illegal substance abuse circumstance arises, I will not be permitted to practice or play in any interscholastic competition. A course of action will be determined to provide appropriate counseling between the school and family.
3. If a third occurrence of substance abuse were to take place, I will be referred to the Athletic Substance Abuse Review Board (A.S.A.R.B.). I will be suspended from all athletic events until the A.S.A.R.B. schedules a hearing review to determine my continued eligibility.

Finally, I agree to call you if I am ever in a situation that threatens my safety and to communicate with you regularly about issues of importance to us both.
